**A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN OF PHILLIPSBURG,
COUNTY OF WARREN, STATE OF NEW JERSEY,
AUTHORIZING REFUND TO FEMA**

WHEREAS, the Town of Phillipsburg sustained damage to the sewer utility plant as a result of Hurricane Sandy; and

WHEREAS, the Town received monies through the Federal Emergency Management Agency (“FEMA”) to assist in the repair of damage sustained at the sewer utility plant; and

WHEREAS, a portion of the monies paid by FEMA to the Town were later found to be covered by the Town’s insurance, resulting in a refund due to FEMA in the amount of \$9,792.00; and

WHEREAS, the Town received correspondence dated December 17, 2015 requesting that a refund check be issued in the amount of \$9,792.00 and made payable to the State of New Jersey, Department Treasurer in order to rectify the inadvertent overpayment; and

WHEREAS, sufficient funding exists as evidenced by the attached Certification of Funds.

NOW THEREFORE IT BE RESOLVED by the Town Council of the Town of Phillipsburg, County of Warren, State of New Jersey, that a refund in the amount of \$9,792.00 is hereby authorized and the C.F.O. is hereby directed to issue said check to the State of New Jersey in accordance with the correspondence dated December 17, 2015.
