Phillipsburg Residents & Business Owners:

RE: 2020 Road Improvements Notification  
Town of Phillipsburg

Dear Property Owners & Residents,

The Town of Phillipsburg will be undertaking a significant roadway resurfacing program for select roadways throughout the Town (see enclosed list). Improvements are anticipated to start on/or about June 2020 and will include investment of nearly \$4,000,000.00 dollars funded through a combination of NJDOT Grants, Utility companies and Municipal Capital Funds. As result of this investment in critical Town infrastructure will entail improvements to approximately 60 roadways consisting of 10.4 Miles of 54 miles of roads under the jurisdiction of the Town and inspection of 49,000 feet of sanitary/stormwater mains and upgrades to 413 sanitary/stormwater castings.

Property owners and residents are provided this notification as prescribed under Town Code 545-39 “Reconstructed and resurfaced streets” to inform the public the proposed improvements will result in a restriction on openings or improvements for a period of five (5) years following completion the project. A copy of the code is available to review in the office of the Town Clerk and online on the Town website.

Property Owners and Residents are advised to complete all planned or anticipated work prior to June 2020. Impacted parties are advised to provide notification to the project contacts listed below of anticipated work that may require disturbing the roadway, as the Town of Phillipsburg will work with Property Owners and Residents to schedule work in a manner to reduce conflict.
