A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN OF PHILLIPSBURG, COUNTY OF WARREN, STATE OF NEW JERSEY, AUTHORIZING THE APPLICATION AND EXEUCTION OF A GRANT AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE TOWN OF PHILLIPSBURG AND THE STATE OF NEW JERSEY BY AND FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION WHEREIN GRANT IDENTIFIER IS FS-16-094

WHEREAS, the Governing Body of the Town of Phillipsburg desires to further the public interest by obtaining a grant from the State of New Jersey in the amount of approximately \$3,000 to fund the following project:

Green Communities Grant

Community Forestry Management Plan

NOW THEREFORE the Governing Body resolves that Dawn L. Slifer or the successor the Office of Superintendent of Recreation, is authorized (a) to make application for such a grant; (b) if awarded, to execute a grant agreement with the State for a grant in an amount not less than \$3,000 and not more than \$3,000, and (c) to execute any amendments thereto which do not increase the grantee's obligations.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Council of the Town of Phillipsburg authorizes and hereby agrees to match fifty percent (50%) of the Total Project Amount, in compliance with the match requirements of the agreement. The availability of the match for such purposes, whether cash, services, or property, is hereby certified. One hundred percent (100%) of the match may be made up of in-kind services (if allowed by grant program requirements and the agreement). The grantee agrees to comply with all federal, state and municipal laws, rules and regulations in its performance pursuant to the agreement.
