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A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN OF PHILLIPSBURG, COUNTY OF WARREN, STATE OF NEW JERSEY,

FINDING AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY FOR

PURPOSES OF N.J.S.A. 40A:11-6 AND N.J.A.C. 5:34-6.1

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A. 40A:11-6 and N.J.A.C. 5:34-6.1 permit contracting of services

without public advertising for bids and bidding therefor, notwithstanding that the contract price

will exceed the bid threshold, when an emergency affecting the public health, safety or welfare

requires the immediate delivery or performance of services; and

WHEREAS, an emergency has arisen affecting the health, safety and welfare of the

citizens of the Town of Phillipsburg to wit, the failure of the Town Hall telephone system, which

failure will prevent communication with the Town residents with various departments within the

Town, including the police department (non-emergency and fax lines), inspections department,

Section 8 administration, among others; and

WHEREAS, in the opinion of the Town's professionals, it is necessary to immediately

replace the telephone system.

NOW THEREFORE IT BE RESOLVED by the Town Council of the Town of

Phillipsburg, County of Warren, State of New Jersey, that the Town Council declares an

emergency to exist as detailed above for which emergency services are needed and authorize the

contracting for replacement of the phone system and payment therefore in excess of the bid

threshold.
