AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF PHILLIPSBURG, COUNTY OF WARREN AND STATE OF NEW JERSEY RENAMING "MERCER STREET PARK" TO BE KNOWN AS THE "JESSE DELGADO RECOVERY PARK"

Section 1.

WHEREAS, Jesse Delgado was a lifelong Phillipsburg resident who resided along Mercer Street and who, subsequent to its construction, spent many hours at the Mercer Street Park; and

WHEREAS, Jesse Delgado was an inspiration to many as a coach, mentor and friend; and

WHEREAS, Jesse Delgado fought courageously the demons of addiction, having experienced periods of recovery followed by periods of active use, a pattern which is so common to those afflicted with the disease; and

WHEREAS, Jesse Delgado tragically lost his life to the disease of addiction, despite his courageous fight against it; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council has previously acknowledged the stigma associated with the disease of addiction; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council believes it important to recognize that the disease of addiction is real and that those who are afflicted by it are people from all walks of life and further, that the disease does not recognize class, race, economic or social status; and

WHEREAS, by renaming the Mercer Street Park the "Jesse Delgado Recovery Park" the Town Council believes it can both recognize and honor the life of Jesse Delgado and at the same time call attention to this important issue, both the disease and the stigma attached to those who suffer from it.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Town Council of the Town of Phillipsburg, County of Warren and State of New Jersey that the Mercer Street Park shall henceforth be officially known as the "Jesse Delgado Recovery Park" and commonly referred to as "Delgado Park" and that signage reflecting the name change be erected and installed under the direction of the Office of the Mayor.

Section 2:

<u>Severability</u>. The various parts, sections and clauses of this Ordinance are hereby declared to be severable. If any part, sentence, paragraph, section or clause is adjudged unconstitutional or invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, the remainder of this Ordinance shall not be affected thereby.

Section 3:

<u>Repealer.</u> Any ordinances or parts thereof in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed as to their inconsistencies only.

Section 4:

<u>Effective Date.</u> This Ordinance shall take effect upon final passage and publication as provided by law.

RESOLUTION 2021-193

A RESOLUTION DESIGNATING USW, LLC AS REDEVELOPER AS THE SUCCESSOR ENTITY OF STATELINER LLC FOR THE RIVERFRONT REDEVELOPMENT PLAN

WHEREAS, the Town of Phillipsburg has previously adopted the Riverfront Redevelopment Plan (the "Plan") in accordance with the laws of the State of New Jersey and in particular the Local Redevelopment and Housing Law ("LRHL"), N.J.S.A. 40A:12A-1, et. seq. after declaring the area encompassed by the Riverfront Redevelopment Plan an area in need of redevelopment ("Riverfront Redevelopment Area"); and

WHEREAS, the Town Council, as the Redevelopment Entity, issued a Request for Proposals ("RFP") seeking development proposals for a portion of the land located in the Riverfront Redevelopment Area, and more particularly an area designated as Sub Area – 1 (Waterfront North) in the Riverfront Redevelopment Plan (the "Property"); and

WHEREAS, the Town designated Stateliner LLC as the Redeveloper responsible for effectuating the purposes and intent of the Riverfront Redevelopment Plan, Sub Area 1 (Waterfront North) and constructing the project in accordance with the Riverfront Redevelopment Plan, Sub Area 1 (Waterfront North) and in the spirit of the proposal submitted by Stateliner United in response to the RFP (the "Project"); and

WHEREAS, Stateliner reorganized and formed a joint venture for the Project and is now known as USW, LLC with contact information as follows: c/o Fitzpatrick Lentz & Bubba, 645 Hamilton St Suite 800, Allentown, PA 18101, ATTN: Colin Keefe, Esq.; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council desires to reaffirm that USW, LLC is the designated redeveloper of the Property and that any rights heretofore given to Stateliner United, LLC shall inure to the benefit of USW, LLC

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Town Council of the Town of Phillipsburg, County of Warren State of New Jersey that USW, LLC is designated as the redeveloper of the Property and that any rights heretofore given to Stateliner United, LLC shall inure to the benefit of USW, LLC.

RESOLUTION AMENDING RESOLUTION 2021- 186 IN ORDER TO CORRECT THE BLOCK/LOT IDENTIFIED THEREIN

WHEREAS, Resolution 2021-186 was adopted on July 20, 2021 by the Town Council whereby the Town Council approved the construction of a light industrial/manufacturing/warehouse project on property owned by Peron Construction, L.L.C. and identified in the Resolution as Block 2102 Lots 2 and 11 (Howard Street); and
