First and foremost we offer our deepest condolences to the family of Kevin Johnson on his untimely passing. The Town of Phillipsburg is grateful for his diligent service to the community and he will be greatly missed by all of his colleagues.

We recently took delivery of our Odra MT4H street sweeper which replaces our former Johnston sweeper which is over a decade old. The new sweeper will facilitate the Department of Public Works' ability to sweep out streets quickly and efficiently and the old sweeper will be kept as a backup, enabling us to make a strong commitment to consistently clean streets.

Preparation continues for the Railroad Festival, Pork Roll-Palooza and Ole Town Festival and the Mayor's Office as well as the Business Administrator are working collaboratively with the many community groups and volunteers involved in order to ensure the success of these important events for our town.
