WHEREAS, under current law and regulations, the Town is required to reimburse the Warren County Sheriff's Department for the training costs incurred by it related to the training of the Employee; and

WHEREAS, the County of Warren has advised the Town that the reimbursable training costs are in the amount of \$15,614.84 ("Training Reimbursement Costs");

WHEREAS, a condition of the hiring of the Employee, is for the Employee to reimburse the Town for the Training Reimbursement Costs.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Town of Phillipsburg, County of Warren and State of New Jersey that it hereby authorizes and approves the Agreement for Reimbursement of Costs of Training subject to the final review and approval of the Town Solicitor.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Mayor of the Town of Phillipsburg is authorized to execute said Agreement and take any other steps necessary to carry out the intent of this Resolution
