RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AWARD OF A CONTRACT FOR PROFESSIONAL SERVICES WITH RK OCCUPATIONAL & ENVIRONMENTAL ANALYSIS, INC FOR RIGHT TO KNOW SERVICES

WHEREAS, the Town of Phillipsburg has a need to acquire professional services relative to the conducting of Right to Know compliance ("Project"); and

WHEREAS, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:11-5(1)(a)(i), a contract for such services may be awarded without competitive bidding by reason that such services constitute "professional services" which are services rendered or performed by a person authorized by law to practice a recognized profession, whose practice is regulated by law and the performance of which services requires knowledge of an advanced type in a field of learning acquired by a prolonged formal course of specialized instruction and study as distinguished from general academic instruction or apprenticeship; and

WHEREAS, RK Occupational and Environmental Analysis, Inc., submitted a proposal dated May 18, 2022, to provide services relative to the Project; and

WHEREAS, the value of these services is NOT TO EXCEED the sum of \$2,825.00; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council finds it to be in the best interest of the Town of Phillipsburg to authorize said work, which work is not subject to public bidding; and

WHEREAS, sufficient funds are available as evidenced by the attached certification of funds.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Town Council of the Town of Phillipsburg, County of Warren, State of New Jersey, that the Mayor and Municipal Clerk are authorized to enter into a Contract with RK Occupational and Environmental Analysis, Inc., for an amount NOT TO EXCEED the sum of \$2,825.00.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Clerk is hereby authorized and directed to cause a notice to be published in the manner provided by law setting forth the nature, duration, service and amount of the Contract and that the resolution and Contract are on file in the Office of the Clerk and are available for public inspection.

Town of Phillipsburg Right-To-Know Compliance Services

A. Right-To-Know (NJAC 8:59)

RK Occupational & Environmental Analysis, Inc. will provide the following services to assure compliance with respective on-going employer responsibilities under the Right-to-Know Law.

Right-To-Know Survey

- 1. Inventory all products and chemicals in all Board of Education facilities. Surveys must be filed for all District buildings.
- 2. Enter field inventory data into proprietary RK computer program and prepare a printout listing all New Jersey Department of Health (NJDOH) reportable Hazardous Substances. The listing includes container codes, CAS numbers, mixture codes, number of employees exposed, products and their locations.
- 3. Prepare RTK Survey and electronically file with the NJ Dept of Health. Provide one Master Copy of the completed RTK Survey for signature and distribution by the District to the responsible local agencies.

Generate Labels

- 1. Prepare a complete set of labels as required for Hazardous Substances conforming to N.J.A.C. 8.59 for containers not already labeled. Labels will show the contents of the product, the C.A.S. number for each component and indicate the hazards of those substances known to be special health hazards (ie. those which are flammable, corrosive, reactive, carcinogenic, mutagenic, or teratogenic).
- 2. RK will provide a computer printout of locations of all containers (e.g. Room 112-Flammable Storage Cabinet) and indicate which require labels.

Apply Labels - optional

If requested, RK will physically apply labels to all containers as required by N.J.A.C. 8.59-5.8 at the unit cost quoted.

Hazard Communication Standard/Globally Harmonized System Training

Hazard Communication training is required for all "exposed or potentially exposed" employees. For a typical school district this would include science, art, industrial arts, nurses, office personnel (if they handle chemicals), custodial and maintenance staff, bus drivers, and grounds personnel. It is also recommended that a representative from the administration attend so that they are aware of requirements.

The Globally Harmonized System (GHS) of Classification and Labeling of Chemicals is a worldwide initiative to promote standard criteria for classifying chemicals according to their health, physical and environmental hazards. It uses pictograms, hazard statements, and the signal words "Danger" and "Warning" to communicate hazard information on product labels and safety datasheets in a logical and comprehensive way. The primary goal of GHS is better protection of human health and the environment by providing chemical users and handlers with enhanced and consistent information on chemical hazards. The focus of the GHS standard is on the right of

employees to understand the hazards associated with the chemicals they work with as opposed to simply having the right to know those substances.

Safety Data Sheets - optional

The effort to prepare the RTK Survey and container labels assumes that we have access to copies of District's SDS files. Additionally, all public employers are required by the RTK law to maintain copies of SDS's for all products or substances used in their facilities and make these available to their employees upon request. Current and accurate SDS's are also necessary to produce proper labels and RTK surveys.

If required, SDS will be obtained directly from the suppliers as needed to update the District's SDS files. RK can also search our database of 20,000 SDS's for the products found on the survey. If a complete set of up to date SDS's is available in the District files, then this service is not necessary.

Right-To-Know Administrative Procedures - optional

RK will audit for completeness and proper documentation in District files, proper location, presence of poster, proper procedures, etc. for compliance with administrative requirements of the Law and will correct any deficiencies found. This would include the preparation of RTK Central File and distribution of appropriate materials to the required local files.
