A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN OF PHILLIPSBURG, COUNTY OF WARREN, STATE OF NEW JERSEY, AUTHORIZING AWARD OF A CONTRACT FOR PROFESSIONAL SERVICES WITH AQUATIC FACILITY DESIGN INCORPORATED TO COMPLETE A LIMITED KARST HAZARD REVIEW

WHEREAS, the Town of Phillipsburg (the “Town”) has a need to acquire professional services relative to engineering services required to complete a limited karst hazard review of the ongoing pool development at Walters Park to identify potential karst hazards (the “Project”); and

WHEREAS, the Town has, pursuant to the mandates of State law, sought proposals for said professional engineering services; and

WHEREAS, Aquatic Facility Design, Inc. (“AFD”), submitted a proposal dated April 5, 2022, to provide services through Colliers Engineering & Design (“CED”) relative to the Project; and

WHEREAS, CED, through AFD, was found to be qualified to perform said professional services and has submitted a conforming proposal found to be in the best interests of the Town; and

WHEREAS, the value of these services shall not exceed \$4,750.00; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council finds it to be in the best interest of the Town to authorize said work, which work is not subject to public bidding.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Town Council of the Town of Phillipsburg, County of Warren, State of New Jersey, as follows:

The Mayor and Town Clerk are hereby authorized and directed to execute this Professional Services Agreement with AFD to enable CED to complete a limited karst hazard review of the ongoing pool development to identify potential karst hazards, **NOT TO EXCEED** \$4,750.00, as described therein, subject to the certification of funds.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Deputy Clerk is hereby authorized and directed to cause a notice to be published in the manner provided by law setting forth the nature, duration, service, and amount of the Contract and that the resolution and Contract are on file in the Office of the Clerk and are available for public inspection.
