CLEAN STREETS PROGRAM YEAR 1**


WHEREAS, the Town of Phillipsburg UEZ Program desires to submit for and obtain a grant from the New Jersey Department of Community Affairs not to exceed the amount of \$212,500.00 to be used to fund litter patrol, business wayfinding and visitor assistance within the UEZ district for a 12 month period.

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED, that the Town of Phillipsburg does hereby authorize the application for such funding; and, recognizes and accepts that the Department may offer a lesser or greater amount and therefore, upon receipt of the funding agreement from the New Jersey Department of Community Affairs, does further authorize the execution of any such funding agreement; and also, upon receipt of the fully executed agreement from the Department, does further authorize the expenditure of funds pursuant to the terms of the agreement between the Town of Phillipsburg UEZ Program and the New Jersey Department of Community Affairs, Division of Urban Enterprise Zone's Zone Assistance Fund; and




