

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN OF PHILLIPSBURG, COUNTY OF WARREN,
STATE OF NEW JERSEY APPROVING FOUR-YEAR EXTENSION TO THE
INACTIVE PERIOD, EFFECTIVE AUGUST 1, 2024.**

LICENSE NUMBER 2119-33-011-006 FROM CLAUDIO'S ITALIAN CAFÉ LLC TO MICHAEL PICHETTO

WHEREAS, the Town Council of the Town of Phillipsburg, County of Warren, State of New Jersey hereby approved the transfer of the aforesaid CLAUDIO'S ITALIAN CAFÉ INC. to MICHAEL PICHETTO, R2024-68, simultaneously with this four-year approval, at a minimum, wherein said license may remain inactive for an additional four years, effective August 1, 2024, and

WHEREAS, the State of New Jersey having passed (S-4265/A-5912) wherein the Division of Alcoholic Beverage Control has issued Administrative Order (AO-2024-03) which shall divide all inactive licenses into quartiles based on the length of inactivity, and

WHEREAS, the quartile of inactive licenses that have been inactive for the longest period of time are required to be activated or transferred within one year, and

WHEREAS, the quartile of inactive licenses that have been inactive for the second longest period of time are required to be activated or transferred within two years, and

WHEREAS the quartile of inactive licenses that have been inactive for the third longest period of time are required to be activated or transferred within three years, and
